Understanding Financial Aid Options

Federal Pell Grant - Up to \$7,395/year

- Available to students with a Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$6,655 or less
- Award pro-rated based on the number of credit hours of enrollment each term
- Available to students who are seeking their 1st Bachelor's Degree

Federal SEOG Grant

- Supplements the Pell Grant
- Amount varies by need and availability

Federal Work Study

- Award varies based on need and other aid

Federal Nursing Student Loan (NSL)

- Requires completion of the FAFSA each academic year.
- Based on financial need and enrollment in the nursing program (minimum half-time enrollment of 6 credits).
- Fixed interest rate: 5%.
- Repayment begins 9 months after dropping below half-time enrollment.
- A promissory note must be completed before funds are disbursed.

Federal Stafford Loan

Subsidized: No interest while in school; 6.53% fixed rate

Unsubsidized: Accrues interest while in school; 6.53% fixed rate

Repayment begins six months after graduation

- **Freshman:** \$5,500 (Dependent) / \$9,500 (Independent)
- **Sophomore:** \$6,500 (Dependent) / \$10,500 (Independent)
- **Junior/Senior:** \$7,500 (Dependent) / \$12,500 (Independent)

2 St. Luke's Foundation Scholarships

- Award amounts vary depending on available funds and eligibility.
- Submit your application online



Walker Endowed Scholarship

- Award amounts vary based on available funds
- First- or second-year nursing students with a minimum 2.5 GPA who are dependents of a single-parent household
- Submit your application online

Iowa Tuition Grant - Up to \$7,500/year

- Must be an Iowa resident
- 2026-2027 **FAFSA deadline July 1, 2026** for Spring and Summer 2027
- 2027-2028 **FAFSA deadline July 1, 2027** for Fall 2027
- SAI must be \$16,000 or less
- Award pro-rated based on credit hours and program cost per credit hour

Iowa National Guard Educational Assistance Grant – up to \$9,296/year (and up to \$2,324 in the summer)

- 2026-2027 FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline December 1, 2026 for Spring and Summer 2027
- 2027-2028 FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline July 1, 2027 for Fall 2027
- Active Iowa Army/Air National Guard member & Iowa resident
- Award pro-rated based on credit hours per term

All Iowa Opportunity Scholarship – up to \$5,334/year

- 2026-2027 FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline April 1, 2026 for Spring and Summer 2027
- 2027-2028 FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline April 1, 2027 for Fall 2027
- SAI must be \$10,669 or less
- Available to students who do well in high school and demonstrate financial need
- Award pro-rated based on credit hours per term

Education and Training Voucher (ETV) – up to \$5,000/year

- 2026-2027 FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline December 1, 2026 for Spring and Summer 2027
- 2027-2028 FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline December 1, 2026 for Fall 2027
- Eligibility: Foster care, relative care, adoption, or guardianship after age 16
- Award pro-rated based on credit hours per term

Future Ready Iowa Grant – up to \$3,000 per year

- 2026-2027 FAFSA & Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline July 1, 2026 for Spring and Summer 2027
- 2027-2028 FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application deadline July 1, 2027 for Fall 2027
- Must be 25 years old on July 1 preceding the academic year
- Must be enrolled in a program that leads to a State identified high-demand job
- Award pro-rated based on credit hours per term

- **Federal Parent PLUS Loan:** Fixed interest rate of 8.94%
- **Private Loans for student, parent, or sponsor based on credit-worthiness**
- **Morningside Interest-Free Payment Plans:** 4 month or 2 month
 - Fall: August – November or September – December
 - Spring: January – April
 - Summer: June – July
