- High School Record (GPA)
- Quality of High School Coursework
- ACT Examination Results (or equivalent)
- College Record (if applicable)
- Application Essay
- Shadowing Experience (varies by program)

Admission applications for the academic programs at St. Luke's College are reviewed on a continual basis with academic programs beginning in the Fall (radiology, respiratory care, nursing) Spring (Accelerated BSN), and in the Summer (Nurse Refresher). Bachelor's degree completion programs and general education courses are offered in each semester. Applicants are encouraged to have all required documents submitted well in advance.
