



Radiology Program Selection Criteria

Radiology Program Selection Criteria

Individuals interested in the Radiologic Technology program at St. Luke's College, must apply for admission and meet all College admission requirements of St. Luke's College. In addition, applicants must complete eight (8) hours of job shadowing with a radiologic technologist in a medical center radiology department. At least four (4) of the shadowing hours should be completed at UnityPoint - St. Luke's. Documentation of all shadowing hours is required.

Meeting the minimum admission requirements does not guarantee acceptance to the radiology program. Points are awarded on the following basis:

High School GPA: < 2.5 = 0 points
2.5 – 3.0 = 5 points
3.0 – 3.5 = 10 points
3.5 – 4.0 = 15 points

GED: 5 Points

College GPA: < 2.3 = 0 points
2.3 – 2.5 = 2 points
2.5 – 3.0 = 5 points
3.0 – 3.5 = 10 points
3.5 – 4.0 = 15 points

ACT Composite: < 19 = 0 points
19 – 21 = 5 points
22 – 25 = 10 points
25 or > = 15 points

Number of General Education Courses Completed:

Anatomy & Physiology I and Anatomy & Physiology II = 6 points

All others transferrable college courses = 2 points each

Interview Score: Maximum of 24

Shadow Assessment: Maximum of 25 points

Completion of all Shadow Hours: = 10 Points
